YEAR ELEVEN MOCK EXAMINATIONS FEBRUARY/MARCH 2010

The venue for all examinations is the **GYM** unless otherwise indicated. Candidates should assemble in the large yard immediately before each exam ready to be allocated their places in the exam room. Please refer to the Examination Timetable on the reverse of this letter.

PLEASE NOTE:

A.M. Assembly time 8.45 a.m.

P.M. Assembly time 1.15 p.m.

Between **Monday 22nd February** and **Friday 5th March**, students need only attend school when they have an examination. When students do not have an exam, they are expected to remain at home and make good use of this time for revision purposes. There is no facility within school for revision sessions between examinations. Normal timetable will resume on **Monday 8th March**.

Boys are also reminded that MFL oral examinations are a compulsory part of the subject and should attend at the time stipulated by their language teacher.

ALL boys should be equipped with black pen (+ spare), pencil (+ spare), ruler, rubber, angle-measurer, compasses, and a calculator. These should be contained in a **CLEAR** pencil case or plastic bag.

MOBILE PHONES, PERSONAL TVS/STEREO'S, IPODS, AND MP3 PLAYERS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL. ANY OF THE ABOVE DISCOVERED WILL LEAD TO CANCELLATION OF THE MARKS FOR THAT PAPER. EXAMINATION BOARDS INVARIABLY TAKE DRASTIC ACTION AGAINST STUDENTS WHO BREAK THESE RULES. LAST YEAR SOME STUDENTS FAILED GCSE FOR THIS REASON. PLEASE IMPRESS THIS UPON YOUR SON.

May I draw your attention to the GCSE re-sit modular examinations on both **Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd March**. Many Year 11 boys are sitting these examinations. They form part of their final GCSE Mathematics and Science Grades and are **EXTERNAL** examinations.
